


SPACE... BE INSPIRED!

The Odysseus II project aims to inspire young people to engage in space science and technology through a series of educational activities.

The main activity of the project is a fun-oriented educational contest that combines scientific learning with hands-on experiences. Organized in multiple rounds and around a series of local events and 10 regional sessions per year, the Odysseus II contest targets all pupils and students, wherever they are living and irrespective of their cultural background or language.

Focusing on the creativity of young minds, the Odysseus II contest also seeks to foster networking among youth with science teachers, experts and space industry professionals in a unique international educational network.

Odysseus II Contest for Skywalkers provides pupils from 7 to 13 years old an opportunity to think about space exploration, by creating a picture (drawing, painting, mosaic, photograph, drawing made with computer design programs etc.) that relates to one of the following themes:

- (i) Solar System and Space Science
- (ii) Europe in space
- (iii) Human beings on Mars
- (iv) Astrobiology - The search for life in the universe.

The winners will win iPads with space related e-books and applications, rocket models and medallions.

14-18 Years old



Pupils aged 14 to 18 years old are invited to express their inspiration from space exploration and to have fun, through the preparation of a project on one of the themes of the contest.

Contestants are competing in teams of two or three members with a teacher as a coach and can develop and submit their project in any of the 24 official EU languages.

The members of top teams will win computerized telescopes, paid trips to the locations of the semi-finals and the final, Odysseus contest memorabilia and a dream trip to the Guiana Space Centre.
