## ..... EXAMPLES FROM THE 2015–2016 CONTEST .....

Mars exploration, lunar bases, life in the universe, earth views - just a few examples of work submitted by Skywalker finalists during last year's Odysseus contest. National winners received a real flying rocket to perform experiments and competed in the European finals for additional prizes.

## ..... HOW TO PARTICIPATE .....

### WHAT TO DO



In the **Skywalkers** category (**ages 7-13**), pupils participate **as individuals** with the support of a supervising adult (a teacher or parent, for example). They should prepare an original image dealing with space. The image can be produced manually (a drawing, painting, mosaic, etc.) or in digital form (using a camera or computer design program). If produced manually, the image must then be digitally photographed or scanned for submission.

### THEMES



The solar system and space sciences, Europe in space, Humans on Mars, Astrobiology - the search for life in the universe.

### IMAGE SUBMISSION



The **deadline** for submission (delivery date) is **March 31, 2017**. Images must be submitted online using the profile created by the supervising adult during the registration phase.

### PRIZES



A jury will select the national and European winners. The winning pupils will have their images displayed and they will be awarded telescopes and/or iPads.

The Skywalkers category is split into two groups: Juniors - ages 7 to 10; and Seniors - ages 11 to 13.

Each supervising adult can submit entries for up to 50 pupils. Each participant must have an adult consent form signed by his or her parent or legal representative.
